For the LORD is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.</p>	<p><b>April 26</b></p> <p><i>Philippians 4:4-9</i></p> <p>Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.</p>	<p><b>April 27</b></p> <p><i>John 15:1-17</i></p> <p>If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.</p>	<p><b>April 28</b></p> <p><i>Micah 6</i></p> <p>...And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.</p>	<p><b>April 29</b></p> <p><i>Haggai 2:1-9</i></p> <p>"The silver is mine and the gold is mine" declares the Lord Almighty. "The glory of this present house," says the Lord Almighty "And in this place I will grant peace," declares the Lord Almighty.</p>	<p><b>April 30</b></p> <p><i>Phil. 4:10-20</i></p> <p>And my God will meet all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus.</p>
	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>For a moment, reflect on God's work in your life and in our church. Let praise and gratitude be your first response. Thank Him for His loving kindness, for all the blessings God has showered upon you and our church. Ask Him to guide you in your use of these blessings — your time, your talents, and your treasure — for His glory in this campaign.</p>	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>Write down everything that you are concerned about in any area of your life and the missional campaign. Present them to the Lord in prayer. Ask God to help you choose from now on to make prayer your first choice and to let His peace rule your heart and mind.</p>	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>Discerning God's will in our giving requires preparation of our heart, mind, and will. Ask God for clear direction and wisdom as you consider your role in giving. Ask Him to make your motives pure and show you what it is He wants to do through you in His vision for the missional campaign.</p>	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>As you wait for the Lord's guidance and direction, ask Him to help you follow His will—to be a faithful servant, loving Him with your whole heart and loving your neighbor as yourself. Pray that you and our church would be sensitive to one another's needs.</p> <p>May we do what is good and right and true before the Lord.</p>	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>Giving boils down to four simple words: God owns it all. Psalm 24:1 tells us that the Lord owns everything we have. Ask God to help you put His truth into practice with joy, gratefulness, and contentment. Pray for our Campaign Team to effectively lead us in understanding stewardship.</p>	<p><b>Prayer for the day...</b></p> <p>Sacrificial giving never leaves us in need, but enables us to benefit from the Lord's blessings. Thank God for the way He has blessed you and your family.</p> <p>Ask Him to speak to your heart and help you understand what He would have you give to this campaign. Pray that He would strengthen your faith and give you courage to trust Him so you may be confident in giving abundantly.</p>
